THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PERTH

BY-LAW NO. 3675

A by-law to provide for permits and fees for various services provided by the Corporation of the Town of Perth

WHEREAS, under the provisions of subsection 391. (1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25., provides that despite any Act, a municipality and a local board may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons,, for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board; and for property including property under its control.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Perth is desirous of enacting such a by-law.

Recitals (26Sep2017):

1. The Committee of the Whole reviewed and concurs with the staff recommendation as presented in Report 2017-COW-9.3, to remove the Foster Street Banner Pole fee of \$150.00, and replace it with \$110.00, plus HST per week.
2. The Council for The Corporation of the Town of Perth deems it advisable to pass this By-law.

Recitals (29Aug2017):

1. The Committee of the Whole reviewed and concurs with the staff recommendation as presented in Report 2017-COW-8.5, to:
 - a) Insert under "Authorization" the recital exempting specific fees and deposits from the Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase provision of the By-law as approved by By-law No. 3675-49, dated December 20, 2016.
 - b) Add, under the list of exempted fees from the Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase "Busking Permit Fees".
 - c) Amend Schedule 'E', Protective and Fire Services, to re-establish the initial Busking Permit Fees and add a Student Fee structure.
2. The Council for The Corporation of the Town of Perth deems it advisable to pass this By-law.

1. The Committee of the Whole reviewed and concurs with the staff recommendation as presented in Report 2017-COW-5.8, to amend By-law No. 3675, Schedule 'A' to include a Non-Reservation Seasonal Rate of \$2.50 per foot (HST included) for Commercial Fleet Operators who maintain a minimum fleet of three (3) boats at twenty-seven (27) feet or greater in length at Last Duel Park.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth hereby enacts as follows:

Authorization (29Aug2016):

- 1.1. Amend Schedules 'A' through to 'F' to annually increase the fees based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI), rounded up to the next ten cents (\$0.10); with the exception of:
 - 1.1.1. Late Payment Charges on Taxes;
 - 1.1.2. Utilities and Accounts Receivable;

- 1.1.3. Utility Holdbacks;
- 1.1.4. Lottery Licenses;
- 1.1.5. Planning Security Deposits, and;
- 1.1.6. Busking Permit Fees.

Authorization (22Nov2016):

- 1.1. That all users be allowed to pay for the fees and charges in Schedule 'A' with a credit card.
- 1.2. That all Schedules be amended on an annualized basis (October to October timeframe) to reflect changes as per the Ontario Consume Price Index (CPI).

Schedules:

- 1.1 That the Town of Perth enact the following fees and charges, as set out in the attached:
 - 1.1. That all Schedules be amended on an annualized basis (October to October timeframe) to reflect changes as per the Ontario Consume Price Index (CPI).
 - 1.2. That the Consumer Price Index (CPI) change be completed prior to the end of the year and factored into the annual budget.
