

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PERTH

BY-LAW NO. 4856

A By-law to waive all penalties and interest for late payment of property taxes and water & sewer invoices and suspend all tax sale activities for a six (6) month period

Recitals:

1. The Provincial State of Emergency related to COVID-19 is impacting earnings for many persons and businesses. Waiving of future penalties and interest on any outstanding payment to the Town for water or property taxes will provide some financial relief for our community.
2. The maximum impact of this By-law on the 2020 Proposed Budget is estimated to be \$71,000.
3. Council has reviewed staff report 2020-COUNCIL-6.AI-1 at their meeting held on Tuesday, March 24, 2020.
4. Council for The Corporation of the Town of Perth deems it advisable to pass this By-law.

Accordingly, the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Perth enacts as follows:

1. AUTHORIZATION:

- 1.1 Pass By-Law No. 4856, being a By-Law to waive all penalties/interest for late payments of property taxes and water & sewer invoices for six (6) months, as well as suspending all tax sale activities;


Further, the Treasurer shall provide an August Committee Of The Whole Report outlining re-payment plan for all properties who utilize the aforementioned taxation penalties/interest and water and sewer taxation relief period; and

Further, the tax sale prohibition shall resume post the above noted re-payment period.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE:

- 2.1 This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date it is passed by Council.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this the 24th day of March, 2020.
