**Town of Perth – Immediate Facility Closure**

**Perth, Ontario** – The Town of Perth has seen a substantial increase in COVID-19 cases in the past few days and as a result, the Leeds Grenville Lanark Health Unit has issued a Class Order restricting several social activities within the Town.

Mayor John Fenik states, “This is a very serious situation and it is extremely important that Perth citizens stay in line with the COVID-19 protocols of wearing masks and social distancing. Please reduce your extracurricular activities with others if possible and be sure to get tested if you have any symptoms at all. We need to come together as a strong community now to stop this current spread.”

The following measures are effective in the Town of Perth as of 12:01 am on 17 March, 2021:

- All municipal facilities, including the Town Hall, the Indoor Pool, the Community Centre (Arena) and the Museum will be closed to the public. Appointments can be made for essential services. The drop box at the front door of Town Hall remains available to the public.
- Outdoor recreation facilities such as Conlon Farm (including Toboggan Hill), Last Duel Park, Stewart Park and Darou Farm are open to the public. Social distancing must be followed at all times and gatherings are limited to a maximum of 5 people.
