Re-Opening of Town Hall, Indoor Recreation Facilities, Tourism Information Centre

Perth, Ontario – As announced today by the Province of Ontario, the Grenville Leeds & Lanark Health Unit will be re-opening in the Green Zone of the Ontario COVID-19 Response Framework. As a result, the Town of Perth will be re-opening the Town Hall, Indoor Pool, Community Centre (Arena) and the Tourism Office/Museum under the COVID-19 protocols required for the Green Zone.

The Town Hall will re-open on Tuesday, February 16th and will be open from Monday to Friday from 10:00 am until 3:00 pm. All visitors will be asked to enter the front door and exit by the side door. A maximum of 6 customers will be admitted into the building at any one time and the required cleaning protocols will be in place. Residents are encouraged to continue to do business over the phone or online if possible. If you are coming to Town Hall or another facility to meet with a member of staff, please call or email in advance as Staff will continue working from home periodically, as required by the Province.

The Perth and District Indoor Pool will re-open on Tuesday, February 16th with limited programs in the first week to provide time for patrons to reserve their swim times. Aquafit reservations will be on Wednesday February 17th and Lane Swim reservation will be on Thursday February 18th. Only Lane Swims will be available and users must reserve a spot in advance. The Visitor Information Centre and the onsite public washroom will re-open on Saturday, February 20th and will remain open Wednesday to Sunday from 10:00 am until 3:00 pm. Some portions of the Perth Museum will also be open. For further details call 613-267-1947 and to book an appointment to visit the Museum go to www.perth.ca/museum. Visitors to the Museum or those seeking information can enter from the courtyard on the north side of the building, and request assistance from Staff.

The public washrooms outside Town Hall continue to be open from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm daily.

Mayor John Fenik states, "I am happy to see our region start to re-open. It has been a long winter and the pandemic has taken a toll on the mental health of our citizens. Spring is on the way and this is a step in the right direction. Please continue to follow the guidance of the the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit and stay home if you have any symptoms of COVID-19."
