## The Opportunity:

Reporting to the Manager of Aquatic Services, the Perth & District Indoor Pool Part-Time Evening/Weekend Supervisor is responsible for the shift supervision of pool staff and patrons at the Indoor Pool.

## What you will do:

Perform the responsibilities of the position within the legislative and regulatory standards as set out in all applicable provincial and municipal regulations, policies, and by-laws.

- Supervise the activities of the shift Lifeguards, Instructors and deck assistants to ensure performance of established job-related duties per position job descriptions.
- From time to time as required during the absence of the Manager of Aquatic Services, temporarily fulfills the role of designated "Operator" in accordance with O. Reg. 565 made to the Health Protection and Promotion Act, as amended from time to time.
- Monitor and maintain a safe standard of activities and cleanliness of pool deck, change rooms, lobby, hallways, and multi-purpose room.
- Oversees the front desk operation, reception, including but not limited to the intake for all monies during shift, maintaining program statistics, etc.
- Aid patrons with all inquiries in a professional manner.
- Assist with swim lesson registrations, course registrations, Speedo sales, special events and other activities as outlined by the Manager of Aquatic Services.
