Perform the responsibilities of the position within the legislative and regulatory standards as set out in all applicable provincial and municipal regulations, policies, and by-laws.

- Observes patrons and enforces the health and safety regulations of the pool.
- Completes mandatory pool chemical tests including the addition of pool chemicals as required.
- Administers First Aid, CPR, and AED as required. Responsibility of upgrading or regular maintenance of CPR training, First Aid awards, biannual upgrading of National Lifeguard.
- Assists with pool preparation and set-up for special events or programs.
- Attends all in-service meetings and is up-to-date with regard to information related to the facility.
- Other duties as assigned.
