

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PERTH

By-Law No.1818.

By-Law prohibiting the Discharge of Air-guns or Spring-guns
In the Town of Perth.

WHEREAS the revised Statutes of Ontario 1950 has amended in 1951 (Paragraph 37 of subsection 1 of section 388) to permit local municipalities to prohibit or regulate the discharge of air-guns or spring-guns:

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Perth deem it expedient to pass such a By-law;

THEREFORE the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Perth enacts as follows:-

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge an air-gun or spring-gun within the limits of the said Town of Perth.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry either an air-gun or spring-gun within the limits of the said Town of Perth without the written consent of the Chief of Police.
3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this By-law shall be subject to a penalty of not more than (\$50.00) Fifty dollars exclusive of costs and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the Ontario Summary Convictions Act.
